DIVISION I: HORTICULTURE “Green House”

Eligible for the “Green Thumb” Division Award (\$25.00)

Eligible for “Best in Class” Awards (\$10.00)

Submit two photos (front and top views) of each plant against a neutral background.

Subject line of e-mail is “Virtual Show/ Hort/ Class ____”. In e-mail, include exhibitor’s name, correct binomial name of exhibit, and exhibitor’s Garden Club name.

Limit one entry per Class.

Section A: “Lovely Leaves”

Container plant grown for foliage. Maximum diameter of container 12”

Class 1: Begonia

Class 2: Cactus

Class 3: Philodendron

Class 4: Any succulent other than Cactus

Class 5: Any Other foliage plants

Section B: “Flowering Delights”

Container plants grown primarily for flowers and must be in bloom.

Maximum diameter of container 12”.

Class 6: Orchid

Class 7: Saintpaulia, African Violet, standard size

Class 8: Saintpaulia, African Violet, small and miniature sizes

Class 9: Any other Gesneriad (Gloxinia, Streptocarpus, etc.)

Class 10: Any Other flowering plant

DIVISION II: DESIGN “Creative Quarantine”

Eligible for the “Design Diva” Division Award (\$25.00)

Eligible for “Best in Class” Awards (\$10.00)

Note: All Designs must be composed of fresh and/or dried or treated dried plant material and other components.

Submit one photo of design from front of exhibit (shown at eye level for Petite Designs). Exhibitor to provide background and underlay.

Subject line of e-mail is “Virtual Show/Design/Class ____” In e-mail, include exhibitor’s name, a list of plant material used in the exhibit, and exhibitor’s Garden Club name.

Class 1: “All by Myself”

A Functional Tray for One Table Design with decorative unit. The designer has freedom to choose Traditional or Creative style.

Exhibitor provides tray and underlay.

4 reservations

Class 2: “A Brighter Tomorrow”

Designer’s Choice of Floral Design style staged in a space 20” long x 20” wide x 30” high. Exhibitor to provide background panel and underlay. (20” x 30” is standard size of Dollar Store foam panel.)

4 reservations

Class 3: “Zoom In”

A Petite Design that must approach but not exceed 5” in height, width and depth. Exhibitor to provide background and underlay.

4 reservations

Keep Class 4: “Reaching Out”

A Petite Design that must approach but not exceed 12” in height, width, and depth. Exhibitor to provide background and underlay.
