## Civic Projects

- Eden Chamber of Commerce Town Park, corner of Main & W. Church Street. We plan and maintain this park in conjunction with the Eden Chamber.
- Planting the hanging baskets that adorn Main Street in Eden during the summer months.
- Planting plugs into 4” pots and maintain them in the Eden Central School Greenhouse until ready to be planted into the pots that go on the street corners and Swartz Field.
- Garden Therapy: Members donate socks, holiday cards, puzzles, coloring books, candy and bath & body items for the residents during the Christmas season. Every month members decorate the main hallway with items to coincide with the holiday/theme for that month. Members also plant the flower boxes and planters in June.
- Plant flowers and maintain the flower bed at the Blue Star Memorial Marker. Place a wreath at the marker during the Christmas season and Memorial Day.
- Plant and maintain vegetables at the Asa Warren House. Vegetables are donated to the Eden-North Collins Food Pantry. Every month all members donate a selected grocery item to be given to the pantry. Lettuce is planted and grown in the school greenhouse also.
